ITINERARY DETAILS


DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN DELHI

BY: INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT

Upon arrival in Delhi, you will be transferred to your hotel check-in and Dinner in Hotel.

DAY 2: DELHI

Breakfast at hotel. After Breakfast Proceed for Delhi sightseeing. This morning You will visit Jama Masjid, Rajghat, and enjoy Rickshaw Ride in old Delhi. Lunch at local restaurant (by own). Post lunch visit Qutub Minar- the second tallest minaret of India and Humayan Tomb UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Overnight stay and Dinner at hotel.

DAY 3: DELHI - AGRA**BY: SURFACE (250 KMS. / 06 HRS.)**

Breakfast at hotel after breakfast drive to Agra. The magnificent fortified ancient city of the Mughal Empire. Arrive and Lunch at Local Restaurant at own and then processed to visit Taj Mahal, a white-marble mausoleum which epitomizes love. Reckoned as one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the structure looks mesmerizing during sunrise. Standing majestically on the banks of River Yamuna, the outstanding monument cast a spell on the visitors. Later visit Agra Red Fort and Marble Inlay factory.



Overnight stay and Dinner at hotel.

DAY 4: AGRA - RANTHAMBORE**BY: SURFACE (256 KMS. / 05 HRS. APPROX)**

Breakfast at hotel ,After breakfast drive to Ranthambore. Enjoy a halt en route at the Fatehpur Sikri. The quaint charm and beauty of the red buildings will make you fall in love with the place. The magnificent fortified ancient city served as the short-lived capital of the Mughal Empire. Important attractions of the city are Mahal of 'Jodha Bai' and Buland Darwaza.



Once done with exploring the historic city, resume your drive towards the Tiger Reserve Park. Overnight stay and Dinner at hotel.

DAY 5: RANTHAMBORE

Leave the comforts of the hotel for morning wildlife safari in Ranthambore national Park. Spot a number of species of flora and fauna residing comfortably in their natural habitat in the park. Enjoy the adrenaline rush as you spot a tiger wandering in the area. After the exciting experience, return to the hotel for having your breakfast. Then again, get ready for afternoon safari in the park. Counted as one of India's most renowned national parks, the Ranthambore National Park has served as the hunting grounds of the royals of Jaipur. Because of the presence of the ancient ruins inside, the national park is also considered as a prominent heritage site. After soaking-in the charm of the national park, return to the hotel for an overnight stay and Dinner.



DAY 6: RANTHAMBORE - JAIPUR

BY: SURFACE (190 KMS. / 04 HRS.)

Today Early morning you will again Hit the Ranthambore national park to watch Tiger and its Habitat. Back to Hotel and after breakfast, you are going to enjoy a ride to Jaipur, the 'Pink City'. After arriving Jaipur Check-in and Relax for while, In the Evening Proceed to Witness Aarti Ceremony of Lord GOVIND DEV JI (Lord Krishna) The temple is dedicated to Govind Dev Ji (Lord Krishna). This temple is among the 7 temples of Thakur of Vrindavan including Sri Radhavallabh ji, Shri Bankey Bihari Ji, Shri Govind Dev Ji and four others. The image of the deity (murti) was brought from Vrindavan here by Raja Sawai Jai Singh II, the founder of Jaipur. According to popular legend, Lord Krishna's image in the temple looks exactly like Krishna's form during his incarnation on Earth.



Overnight stay and Dinner at hotel.

DAY 7: JAIPUR

Breakfast at hotel, after refreshing breakfast, you will explore the 'Pink City' Jaipur. In First half you will visit Hawa Mahal the Palace of Winds (Photo stop) afterwards you will proceed for Amber fort With joy Elephant ride to reach to the gate of the Fort. After fort time for Carpet and Jewelry shopping. Lunch at Palace Café (Own) .In Second Half You will Visit The City Palace and Jantar mantar (Astronomical Observatory). Later in the evening come back to the hotel stay and Dinner at Hotel.



DAY 8: JAIPUR- JODHPUR

BY: SURFACE (320 KMS. / 07 HRS.)

Today after breakfast, you are going to enjoy a ride to Jodhpur, the 'Blue City' or the 'Sun City' of Rajasthan. It is named after its founder Rao Jodha, a chief of the Rathore clan, who founded the city in the year 1459. Enroute you will Visit Holy City Pushkar where you will visit the various Ghats (jetty) and ONLY BRAHAMA TEMPLE of Country.



Later Arrive Jodhpur Overnight stay and Dinner at hotel

DAY 9: JODHPUR-RANAKPUR

BY: SURFACE (156 KMS. / 03.5 HRS. Approx)

Early breakfast at the hotel. Proceed to visit Mehran garh Fort, located in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, is one of the largest forts in India. Built in around 1459 by Rao Jodha, the fort is situated 410 feet (125 m) above the city and is enclosed by imposing thick walls. After Fort Visit & JaswantThada another Interesting Monument of Jodhpur. Then Enjoy Lunch and drive to Ranakpur.

Upon arrival check in at hotel stay and Dinner at Hotel.



DAY 10: RANAKPUR-UDAIPUR BY: SURFACE (95 KMS. / 02 HRS. Approx)

Breakfast at the hotel. Post breakfast visit Ranakpur Jain Temple (Leather Belts, Bag & Shorts Not Allowed) After that drive to Udaipur. Upon arrival check in at hotel for overnight stay.



DAY 11: UDAIPUR

Breakfast at the hotel.
Post breakfast you will visit Jagdish Temple City Palace & Boat Ride in First Half Post Lunch you will Visit Sahelion Ki Bari "The garden of Maids". Later in the evening drive back to hotel for overnight stay and Dinner.



DAY 12: UDAIPUR - AURNGABAD

BY: FLIGHT

Breakfast at the hotel, Post breakfast you have a Free time to Enjoy Hotel or Explore the City at Your Own Post Lunch proceed for Airport Later in the evening arrive Aurangabad overnight stay and Dinner at Hotel.

DAY 13 : Aurangabad to Ajanta Caves

BY: SURFACE 102 KMS/03 HRS Approx)

Breakfast at the hotel. Post breakfast drive to visit Ajanta caves, the Ajanta Caves are 30 (approximately) rock-cut Buddhist cave monuments which date from the 2nd century. The caves include paintings and rock-cut sculptures described as among the finest surviving examples of ancient Indian art, particularly expressive paintings that present emotion through gesture and pose .



DAY 14: Aurangabad - Mumbai

BY: Flight

Breakfast at the hotel Post breakfast visit Ellora, A UNESCO World Heritage Site It is one of the largest rock-cut monastery-temple cave complexes in the world, featuring Buddhist, Hindu and Jain monuments, and artwork, dating from the 600-1000 Century period. Features the largest single monolithic rock excavation in the world, the Kailasha temple, a chariot shaped monument dedicated to Shiva. The Kailasha temple excavation also features sculptures depicting the gods, goddesses and mythologies found in Vaishnavism, Shaktism as well as relief panels summarizing the two major Hindu Epics.



Later post Lunch drive to Airport. Arrive Mumbai check in at hotel for overnight stay and Dinner.

DAY 15: MUMBAI-AUSTRALIA

Breakfast at hotel, After Breakfast proceed for Mumbai Sightseeing i.e. Drive past through Gateway of India, Visit of hanging Garden, Mani Bhawan and Very Interesting and Famous "DHOBHI GHAT"



After Sightseeing of Mumbai Proceed for International Airport for Onward Flight.
